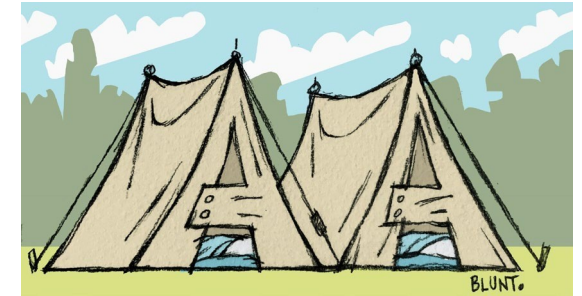

 **You will need to bring your own food for the weekend.** There is a kitchen with a large fridge and cooking facilities. Please bring your own pots, pans, utensils and plates etc. There are also numerous BBQ's on the grounds to use.
